Governor Awards Provista Life Sciences Arizona Innovation Award

Recognizes Provista's Leadership Role in Medical Diagnostics

April 4, 2007--Phoenix, AZ – Provista Life Sciences LLC (Provista), a Phoenix Arizona based medical diagnostics firm, announced that it was the recipient of the Governor of Arizona's prestigious *Arizona Innovation Award*. President & CEO William Gartner accepted the award on behalf of Provista from Arizona Governor Janet Napolitano.

The Governor's *Arizona Innovation Award* recognizes Arizona-based firms who have made significant contributions to the advancement of biotechnology as well as brought recognition to the State of Arizona, domestically and world-wide as a leader in biotechnology research, development and commercialization.

In a press conference held April 3 at Provista Life Sciences headquarters, Governor Napolitano said, "Provista is a leader in medical diagnostics. It is developing blood tests that are changing the face of modern medicine, and giving doctors and families more treatment options to extend patients' quality of life."

"Provista Life Sciences seeks out and secures the rights to novel, underdeveloped medical diagnostics technologies. We then provide the necessary operational management, business development and oversight to shepherd these diagnostics through their respective commercialization efforts into the public domain", says Gartner. "Early detection leads to earlier health care intervention and management and, in turn, improved survival rates for many devastating diseases that may otherwise go unnoticed until it's too late."

Two new diagnostics being readied for commercial introduction by Provista are the BT Test™, a blood test for the early detection of breast cancer, and the RCP-Dx Test™, also a blood diagnostic for several estrogen-related cancers, such as uterine, cervical and ovarian. According to Gartner, Provista anticipates having these test available to the public as early as the summer of 2007. Additionally, in 2008, Provista is expected to make available a third blood test, the LymPro Test®, for the early detection of Alzheimer's disease.

Following the presentation, the Governor toured Provista's facility and their clinical laboratory operations, Provista Diagnostics (PDx). PDx is a CLIA registered laboratory dedicated to accelerating the clinical development and market place introduction of the diagnostic technologies under the Provista Life Science's management umbrella.
